Samples of the fraudulent documents are herewith attached for your attention.

The NEPAD Planning and Coordination Agency (NPCA), further requests the intervention of all diplomatic missions to communicate this incidence of fraud to their States for onward dissemination to the public and business organizations about the activities of these individuals.
